**ASK FATHER GIDEON****Are Catholics required to believe in the apparitions of Our Lady at Fatima or Lourdes?**

The Church teaches that Catholics are required to accept and believe the truths revealed by Christ to the Apostles. This is the public revelation. The public revelation is found in what has been handed down over the centuries in the life of the Church through Sacred Tradition and the Scriptures. This public revelation is rooted and grounded in the teachings of the Apostles. The Church considers Marian apparitions such as occurred at Lourdes, Fatima, or Guadalupe as private revelations. Since these apparitions are not apostolic in origin, belief in them is not necessary for salvation.

LENTEN SCHEDULE

STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held in the big Church every **Friday** of Lent at **7:00 p.m.**

A **PLENARY INDULGENCE**, under the usual conditions, may be gained for making the Stations of the Cross or, if unable to get to a church, for the pious meditation and reading on the Passion and Death of Our Lord for half an hour. The "usual conditions" are: receiving the sacraments of Penance and Eucharist, praying for the Holy Father's intentions, and having no attachment to sin.

LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE for St. John Vianney is scheduled for **Monday, March 22, at 7:00 p.m.**

LENTEN RULES require Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition, all Catholics 14 years old and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent. **FASTING** as explained by the U.S. bishops means partaking of only one full meal. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening—depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal. **ABSTINENCE** forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products, or condiments made of animal fat.
