Parish Information

The parish religious education program (PREP) of St. John Vianney Catholic Church, with the help of God's grace, strives to bring members of the parish into a deep personal relationship with Christ and His Church. We provide formation programs for children, youth, and adults that help them grow in understanding and acceptance of Catholic doctrine, in active participation in liturgical and sacramental life, embracing the fundamental principles of Catholic morality, and in exercising the life of Catholic prayer. ✨ [saintjohnvianneychurch.org/Religious Ed.htm](http://saintjohnvianneychurch.org/Religious_Ed.htm) ✨

Catholic Adult Formation & Education (CAFÉ): Adults classes are held in the school building Sunday mornings during CCD, at 9:15 am, and Wednesday nights during CROWN. Classes include Church history, Scripture, financial, and Natural Family Planning.

CCD (PreK – 8th): We offer a **nursery in the parish office building** for preschool children to age 3; CCD for grades Pre-K (4 yr. olds) – 8; youth catechesis and ministry; and sacrament preparation. Children's RE classes include periodic visits to the chapel for prayer.

CROWN (Catholic Religion on Wednesday Nights, for adults & Catholic Recreation on Wednesday Nights, for kids): Designed to help foster formation in the faith for the family, CROWN begins with Mass at 6:00 pm, after which we move to the social hall for dinner. At 7:00 pm, there are classes in the school for adults. Recreation for children, middle schoolers, and youth is in the social hall. **Wednesday nights 6:00 – 8:00 pm.**

Jr. and Sr. Girls' Sodality: The Jr. and Sr. Girls' Sodality at St. John Vianney invites girls in grades 6 -12 to meet every third Sunday of the month from 3:00 to 6:00 pm. Dinner is provided.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults): Explore the beautiful Tradition of the Catholic Church. Beginning August 12th, RCIA meets every Sunday morning at 9:15 am in the school through the Easter season.
